

Directions to Coreys Road


Meet-up for the Seward Range is at the Junction of Route 3 and Coreys Rd.

FROM THE SOUTH: Take the Adirondack Northway (I-87) to Exit 30. Turn Left on Rt. 73 toward Keene and Lake Placid, and continue on Rt. 73 for 30 miles. Turn left on Route 86, drive through Lake Placid and head to Saranac Lake. Take Route 3 west toward Tupper Lake. Look for Coreys Road on the left after about 12.5 miles. Meet just off Route 3 at the junction of Coreys Road.

FROM THE NORTH: Take the Adirondack Northway (I-87) south to Exit 34, Keeseville. Follow Rt. 9N to Jay and Rt. 86 to Lake Placid. Stay on Rt. 86 to Saranac Lake. Take Route 3 west toward Tupper Lake. Look for Coreys Road on the left after about 12.5 miles. Meet just off Route 3 at the junction of Coreys Road.

FROM THE WEST: Take Rt. 3 into Tupper Lake. Continue on Rt. 3 toward Saranac Lake. Look for Coreys Road on the right after about 7 miles. Meet just off Route 3 at the junction of Coreys Road.

Notice that Coreys Road splits just before merging with Route 3. ADK hikes meet at the intersection of the eastern branch (the Saranac Lake side) of Coreys Road and Route 3. Please arrive at least a few minutes before the scheduled meet-up time to get your pack ready to go. We have a big day ahead of us.

From this meet-up spot at the intersection of Route 3 and Coreys Road (RED Arrow), we will caravan together 6-miles down a dirt road to the trailhead for the Seward Range.
